

**Boards, Commissions and Committees - Membership
For Mayor and/or City Council Appointments**

Civilian Police Review Board

Reference: *Resolutions 1-91, 2-11*

Purpose: *A. To give citizens a fair and impartial appeal process for complaints of police misconduct or allegations in which a citizen is dissatisfied with the findings of Police Internal Investigations.
B. The Board may act in an advisory capacity to the Chief of Police on various issues such as policies and procedures.*

Appointment: *Mayor* **Members:** *13 members* **Term Length:** *District appointments will be appointed to 1 year terms with a maximum of three consecutive terms 3 years). All other members have 2 year terms and may serve a maximum of two terms 4 years).*

Makeup: *A. At least one member shall be selected from each of the six Council Districts of the City of Toledo.
B. At least one member shall be a member of the N.A.A.C.P. and at least one member shall be representative of the Hispanic community.
C. At least one member shall be a practicing attorney and at least one member shall have a background in human relations.
D. At least three members shall have backgrounds in law enforcement (but not active with the Toledo Police Division).
E. Each board member shall reside in the City of Toledo.
F. The remaining two members may be residents of any part of the City.*
