UNLESS NOTIFIED OTHERWISE, THIS BOIL ADVISORY EXPIRES ON THURSDAY 11/24/16 AT 5:00 P.M. AFTER THIS DATE AND TIME YOU CAN RESUME NORMAL USE OF YOUR WATER. IF THIS BOIL ADVISORY NEEDS TO BE EXTENDED, BEYOND THIS DATE AND TIME, YOU WILL RECEIVE ANOTHER NOTIFICATION.

WE STRONGLY ADVISE YOU TO BRING ALL WATER TO A BOIL, LET IT BOIL FOR AT LEAST THREE MINUTES, AND LET IT COOL BEFORE USING. BOILED WATER SHOULD BE USED FOR DRINKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, WASHING DISHES, AND FOOD PREPARATION DURING THIS BOIL ADVISORY.

Please Note:

- People with compromised immune systems should contact their doctor for additional instructions.
- If you have any lesions or surgical incisions, all the water should be boiled as described above before being used for bathing.
- The water may be used without boiling for washing clothes and for flushing toilets. It may also be used for bathing if you do not have any of the above conditions.
- When the water is turned back on, you may experience air or rust in your water. This is normal. Please run each of your cold-water faucets until the water clears up. Avoid washing clothes or using hot water until you have done this.
