

The City of Toledo Department of Public Utilities (DPU) supplies drinking water for over 450,000 people in northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan.

Rates for Toledo water outside city limits vary by geographic location and are determined by long-term contracts which are based on Toledo's water rates. Some communities buy only water from Toledo; some purchase water and sanitary sewer services. Toledo Sewer charges are comprised of a fixed rate based on meter size, plus a volume charge which is variable, based on water usage.

DPU provides billing services based on fixed rates and water volume for Lucas County and Toledo that covers the costs of sewer and drainage services and utility administration. The utility bill states which entity provides services. DPU collects these funds and returns the appropriate amount to Lucas County.
