

S.T.R.I.V.E. Summer Tutorial Program The Challenge to Succeed

Are you a parent concerned about your child's education? Do you have a High School child who is faced with passing the required Ohio Graduation Test (O.G.T.)? Would you be interested in your child continuing to learn through the summer? You are interested in the S.T.R.I.V.E. (Success through Review Incentive Vision and Effort) Program. The program also includes Anti-Drug Education that is conducted by Officer Wormely as part of the tutoring Program. **The registration fee for this program is \$40.00 by May 31, 2017 and \$55.00 after June 1, 2017 (NON REFUNDABLE). You may register on the first day of class by 8:00 am.**

The program is designed to prepare students with; Math (OGT), Science (OGT), Social Studies (OGT), Reading (EL A 1 9th Grade & ELA 2 10th Grade OST Tutoring Only) Testing for the ELA 1 & 2 will be administered by Toledo Public Schools from July 17th-21st at McKinley Elementary. More information will be given at a later date. The enrichment and instruction are for up to two subjects. The classes will be taught at:

Scott High School (Skill Center) located at; 2400 Collingwood Blvd., Toledo, Ohio 43620.

Classes will be held Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 1:30 pm and will start Monday June 5, 2017 and will run thru June 16, 2017.

The classes are taught by hand picked, caring Toledo Public School Teachers. O.G.T testing will begin June 12, 2017. After instruction students will have the opportunity to take the O.G.T. and if passed by the student it will count towards graduation. The program is not equipped to handle special needs students.

It is mandatory to attend all classes scheduled for the two week period. Any absent the student will exit the program. Student must have a binder per class and dividers. Student must complete all homework assignments and extended responses. Binders checks will be conducted during STRIVE. Any student that does not comply will result in dismissal from program.
