2020 Water Rates – Inside City of Toledo Limits

Fixed Charges:

A fixed charge of \$6.00 per month is applied to each bill.

2020 Water Volume Rates Per 100 cubic feet (ccf) = 748 gallons

Per 100 ccf/ month	
First 160,000 cubic feet	\$2.742 per ccf
Over 160,000 cubic feet	\$1.527 per ccf

Water Rate Information: No minimum rate for water per month. Water is billed based upon the water volume rate as shown above.

2020 Senior/Disabled Homeowner Discount Programs

A 25% discount is provided on water, sewer and storm rates, regardless of income, for the primary single-family, owner-occupied residence of Toledo homeowners or spouses who are 65 or older, or who are totally disabled. Those qualified for the program shall pay a monthly rate which is 25% less than the rates established for the first 667 cubic feet and an amount determined by the rates for all water and sanitary discharge furnished over 667 cubic feet consumed per month. Low income residents eligible for the 25% discount may qualify for an additional 15% reduction in water rates only based on income and household size. Sewer Rate Information: Sewer charges include a fixed rate based on meter size, plus volume, based on water that has passed through the meter. "Winter averaging" can reduce sewer volume charges. Normal household water usage measured over the winter billing period is used as a basis for summer sewer billing so that customers are not charged for wastewater treatment services for water used in the summer for lawn watering and other uses that do not discharge to the sewer.

2020 Storm Water Fixed Rate

Single family and residential duplex properties are considered as one Equivalent Residential Unit (ERU) and pay an average storm water charge of \$3.80 per month. Commercial and industrial customers are charged the same rate of \$3.80 per ERU per month, based on total exterior impervious surface area in square feet divided by 2500. "Impervious" means areas that have been paved and/or covered with buildings or materials that do not allow natural water infiltration, such as concrete, asphalt, rooftop, blacktop, etc.
