**COUNCIL PRESIDENT CHERRY AND THE MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL PRESENT:**

O-097-20 Approving a Petition For Special Assessments for Special Energy Improvement Projects and a Project Plan for the Northwest Ohio Advanced Energy Improvement District under Chapter 1710 of the Ohio Revised Code; to authorize and levy special assessments for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, and improving certain public improvements in the City of Toledo in cooperation with the Northwest Ohio Advanced Energy Improvement District; and to approve an Energy Project Agreement in connection with such improvements and special assessments.

**My Position: Support.**

Ordinance passed at the Toledo City Council meeting of March 10, 2020.

**TOLEDO MUNICIPAL COURT:**

O-098-20 Authorizing an agreement between Justice AV Solutions, a Kentucky corporation (“JAVS”) City of Toledo, by and through, Toledo Municipal Court (“TMC”) for access to JAVS Preventative Maintenance, Support and Services in addition to

audio and visual equipment for the court located at 555 N. Erie Toledo, Ohio 43604; authorizing an expenditures of \$40,553.00 for the year, waiving the requirements of TMC 187 and making certain findings with respect thereto.

**My Position: Support.**

**OFFICE OF THE MAYOR:**

R-099-20 Resolution to protect the mandate to Affirmatively Further the goals of the Fair Housing Act.

**My Position: Support.**

Resolution adopted at the Toledo City Council meeting of March 10, 2020.

**DEPARTMENT OF LAW:**

O-100-20 Authorizing the settlement of the claim of Bernadine Tammarine-Martin for personal injuries for the sum of \$15,000.00 in settlement of the claims of Plaintiff; and authorizing the expenditure of \$15,000.00 from the Risk Management Fund.

**My Position: Support.**

**Ms. Tammarine-Martin suffered through months of rehabilitation and will likely require ankle fusion surgery from an injury caused by stepping into a small hole near an unrepaired sewer inlet on May 10, 2016.**

Ordinance passed at the Toledo City Council meeting of March 10, 2020.

O-101-20 Authorizing the settlement of all claims of Paul Spence in case no. 3:11CV02066 captioned Spence v. City of Toledo, et. al., pending in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio, Western Division before the Honorable Judge Zouhary for the sum of \$14,500; authorizing the expenditure of \$14,500 from the Risk Management Fund.

**My Position: Support.**

**Mr. Spence has alleged violation of his due process rights. He had been taken to the ground and detained on 8/18/2018.**

Ordinance passed at the Toledo City Council meeting of March 10, 2020.

O-102-20 Authorizing the appropriation and expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$1,300,000 from the unappropriated balance of the Storm Water Utility Improvement Fund for various drainage improvement projects; authorizing the mayor to prepare plans and specifications, acquire rights-of-way and easements as

appropriate, accept bids and enter into contracts after due advertising for said drainage improvement projects.

**My Position: Support.**

**Annually, this stormwater program replaces crumbling infrastructure; and corrects drainage and nuisance targets throughout the city.**

Ordinance passed at the Toledo City Council meeting of March 10, 2020.

O-103-20 Authorizing the mayor to execute a one (1) year contract with Taylor Excavating, Inc. with the option for two one (1) year extensions for the purpose of providing sanitary sewer and water kills for the City of Toledo and private demolition projects; authorizing the expenditures of \$187,158 from the Water Operating Fund and \$223,100 from the Sewer Operating Fund.

**My Position: Support.**

**This is done annually to plug the connection to sewer and water services at various properties.**

Ordinance passed at the Toledo City Council meeting of March 10, 2020.

O-104-20 Authorizing the mayor to enter into a one (1) year contract with Taylor Excavating, Inc. with the option for two one (1) year extensions for the purpose of providing sanitary sewer and water kills for the Lucas County Land Bank demolition projects; authorizing the expenditure of \$377,000 from the Expendable Trust Fund.

**My Position: Support.**

**This is the annual tapping of sewer and water services to Land Bank properties.**

Ordinance passed at the Toledo City Council meeting of March 10, 2020.

O-105-20 Authorizing the appropriation and expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 from the Capital Improvement Program Fund for the General Resurfacing Program; authorizing the mayor to prepare plans and specifications, acquire required rights-of-way as appropriate, and enter into contracts for roadway projects within the Division of Engineering Services.

**My Position: Support.**

**This action will fund resurfacing or rebuilding local residential streets with money we currently have available.**

Ordinance passed at the Toledo City Council meeting of March 10, 2020.

- O-106-20 Authorizing the mayor to enter into and execute cooperative agreements between the City of Toledo and the Metropolitan Park District of the Toledo Area and to give consent to the Metropolitan Park District of the Toledo Area for construction of a bike path on Byrne Road from the bridge over Swan Creek to Arlington Avenue within the city limits.

**My Position: Support.**

**Our \$180,000 match for this \$290,000 project will be authorized by this action.**

Ordinance passed at the Toledo City Council meeting of March 10, 2020.

**ITEM LIKELY TO BE GIVEN IMMEDIATE CONSIDERATION:**

- O-107-20 Authorizing the expenditure of \$350,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the repair and restoration of City of Toledo Willy's Park Pool; authorizing contracts necessary for the pool repairs.
